



#### Mirsal2 Enhancements

Dubai Customs is coming up with the following enhancements on Mirsal-2 application. These changes will be available effective 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020.

# 1. Changes of Coastal Export Manifest Printout:

The header information of Coastal Manifest printout (including logo, barcode, Customs Location and vessel information) has now been displayed on all additional pages of Coastal Manifest.

The Destination Port field will now display both <u>Port and Port Country names</u> together on Coastal Manifest printout.

# 2. No change in display order of line items in the updated manifest:

A feature has been provided in Coastal Export Manifest such that whenever a manifest is amended or re-generated, the display order of line items in the re-generated manifest is not changed from that of previous version of manifest.

## 3. Update of Physical Documents Submission Status during amendment:

Physical Documents submission need is mandated based on the Original Declaration submission channel such as On-line, Bureau. The same will followed during amendment of Customs declaration. i.e. if a declaration submitted on-line is getting amended through Customs Bureau office, the physical documents submission will be applicable based on the original on-line submission channel and not based on the amendment made through Customs Bureau office.

## 4. Sealing instruction for clearance of Transit declaration moving through Corridors:

Application of Customs seal is now mandated for Transit goods moving from one port to another port through the internal corridors without entering the local market (e.g. Jebel Ali to Al Maktoum Cargo Terminal). Accordingly, such Transit movement declaration will now see instruction for 'Seal to be applied'. No cargo should be moved without applying the Seal.
